



Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke, an associate professor of development sociology at Addis Ababa University, has extensive experience working with higher education institutions, government sectors, and development partners over the past 22 years. At Addis Ababa University, Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke has served in various administrative capacities, ranging from academic unit-level coordination to a deanship position. Dr. Tesfaye is currently the Director of Research Capacity Building and Management at Ababa University.

Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke mentored more than 50 students (at the MA and Ph.D. levels) over a decade at Addis Ababa University and other regional universities in Ethiopia and East African Communities. Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke also coordinated several projects that positively impacted the lives of rural and urban communities across several localities of Ethiopia, including women's economic empowerment and school-based support for children through community service engagements. Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke also served in advisory positions with various organizations, including the former Ministry of Water, Irrigation, and Energy (MoWIE), and on projects funded by the World Bank, Oxfam America, the International Water Management Institute (IWMI), and the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

Dr. Tesfaye Zeleke has also gained experience attending international platforms and conferences on diverse themes, including migration governance, development practices in Africa, and policy frameworks. Dr. Tesfaye has also served as a member of the following think tanks and organizations: Forum for Social Studies (FSS), Ethiopian Society of Sociologists, Social Workers and Social Anthropologists (ESSWA), Organization for Social Sciences Research in Eastern and Southern Africa (OSSREA), Education for Development Association (EFDA) - Local NGO, and Catering Tourism and Training Institute (CTTI).
